FluMist helps prevent flu in people aged 2 to 49 years. It is a nasal spray flu vaccine that starts working in the nose.§

FluMist continues to stimulate the immune system to help build antibodies against influenza infection in 3 ways:



#### In the nasal passage

to help circulate antibodies throughout the body



#### In cells

to help build up the body's response to infection

#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (cont'd)**

Before getting FLUMIST, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you: are currently wheezing; have a history of wheezing and are under 5 years of age; have asthma; have had Guillain-Barré syndrome (severe muscle weakness); have a weakened immune system or live with someone who has a severely weakened immune system; have problems with your heart, kidneys, or lungs; have diabetes; are pregnant or nursing; or are taking antiviral drugs for the treatment of influenza

### Here are some Frequently Asked Questions about FluMist:

#### 1. Who can FluMist help protect?

The CDC recommends that everyone over the age of 6 months receive an annual flu vaccine. Eligible people between the ages of 2 and 49 may receive FluMist or the flu shot, with no preference given to either option. For everyone else, an age-appropriate flu vaccine should be given.

### 2. How long before the flu vaccine can help protect me?

Studies show that it takes about 2 weeks for protection to develop after vaccination.

#### 3. How long does the flu vaccine last?

Your protection from a flu vaccine declines over time. According to the CDC, flu viruses are constantly changing, so flu vaccines are updated from one season to the next to help protect against the viruses that research suggests will be common during the upcoming flu season. Yearly vaccination is needed for the best protection.

#### 4. What are the possible side effects of FluMist?

FluMist may cause rare but serious side effects, including severe allergic reactions. Seek medical help right away if you experience any allergic reactions, including: hives; swelling of the face, lips, eyes, tongue or throat; throat tightness or trouble breathing.

The most common side effects are runny or stuffy nose, sore throat, and fever over 100 °F.

Other possible side effects include: decreased appetite, irritability, tiredness, cough, headache, muscle ache, and chills.
